

Christian Life and Witness Course

Frequently Ask Questions

What is it?

A three-part study designed to help Christians reignite their faith and share it with others. Teaches basics of evangelism and discipleship in simple format.

When is it?

November 5 through November 25 (3 weeks, 1 lesson per week)

Who teaches it?

Instructors trained by the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association.

Who are the students?

For **everyone**, ages 13 and above.

Where will the classes take place?

Numerous locations will be provided weekly. Each week's classes are identical in content at all locations. Each week select the class that is most convenient and fits your schedule.

What is the time commitment?

Participants attend **one 2-hour class per week, for three consecutive weeks.**

➤ **A Student Class is often planned, called "Youth Emphasis."** Praise music and testimonies will be a part of a special 30-minute section before the actual start time. **Identical material will be covered in all classes** therefore adults are welcome (sit in the rear).

How do I become a counselor at the Celebration?

Everyone is welcome to attend the Christian Life & Witness Classes (CLWC) without any obligation of being a counselor at the Celebration.

However, only those who attend these classes, are at least 13 years old, and turn in an approved Counselor Application, may become counselors at the Celebration.

Pastors are encouraged to set the example for their people by attending all classes. Pastors are needed to be Supervisors of Counselors at the Celebration and must attend week 2 AND 3 of the classes to qualify.

What is the cost?

The classes are free. No registration is necessary. Course books and materials are provided without cost. A free-will offering will be received during the course.
